

RESPONSIBILITY CODE SKATE AT YOUR OWN RISK

- While on the ice, skaters must keep moving in the direction of the flow (counter clockwise)
- NO skating in a reckless manner: excessive speeding, weaving or roughness
- Carrying children while on skates is prohibited, both on and off the ice
- NO more than 3 people holding hands while on the ice
- Helmets are strongly recommended for all skaters
- Throwing snowballs or any other objects is prohibited
- NO shoes allowed on the ice, everyone MUST wear skates
- NO food or beverage allowed on the ice at any time
- NO use of cell phones or headphones while on the ice (pictures and videos allowed)
- NO sitting on or leaving articles on the dasher boards (barrier of the rink)
- NO one is allowed on the ice without skates
- NO one is allowed on the ice during resurfacing
- Children ages 5 and under must ALWAYS be accompanied and supervised by an adult while on the ice
- Skate Assist Walkers can only be operated by one person at a time
- NO strollers allowed on the ice
- NO smoking or vaping in the building
- Foul, abusive or obscene language is prohibited
- All public sessions are subject to a 15 minute ice cut
- NO outside food or drinks are allowed
- No chewing gum allowed in the building
- All skaters renting skates are required to wear socks
- Management reserves the right to ask a customer to change attire that is deemed inappropriate for the Skate Zone family environment

Management and staff will enforce this Responsibility Code for all visitors. Loss of rink privileges and/or criminal prosecution will be imposed as necessary.
